



POLICY 4 BOARD ACCOUNTABILITY

POLICY STATEMENT

The Board is responsible for implementing the Charter goals and is accountable to the Minister of Education, students, parents, staff and the public.

GUIDELINES

1. The Board is accountable through the following:
 - 1.1. Providing opportunities for stakeholders to participate in school-based decision making.
 - 1.2. Developing and implementing an Annual Education Plan (AEP) to achieve the goals set out in the Charter and to fulfill provincial requirements.
 - 1.3. Developing an Annual Education Results Report that provides information to the school community on progress towards achieving the goals set out in the AEP.
 - 1.4. Developing and implementing a budget for the operations of the school.
 - 1.5. Ensuring an annual audit of the financial operations.
 - 1.6. Conducting annual surveys of the students, parents and staff to receive feedback regarding the educational programs.
 - 1.7. Communicating Charter successes to the public.
 - 1.8. External evaluations conducted by The Minister of Education.
